Greenheart continues to invest in Suriname

Suriname's First Wood-Based Bioenergy Plant Arrives In Apoera

Provides Green-Clean Solution For Wood Waste & Substantially Reduces Carbon Emissions

September 6, 2013 - Greenheart Group Limited ("Greenheart" or the "Company") is pleased to announce the delivery of Suriname's first wood-based bioenergy plant to Apoera in West Suriname. The bioenergy plant includes a 1.5 mega-watt steam turbine, expandable to 2.7

mega-watts that will convert wood waste from Greenheart's wood processing facility in Apoera to generate green-clean energy. The bioenergy plant will power the Company's Apoera wood processing facility and substantially reduce carbon emissions by eliminating the consumption of up to 1.6 million litres of diesel a year. Greenheart expects its bioenergy plant to be operational by the end of 2013.

Mr. Judson Martin, Chairman & Chief Executive Officer of Greenheart said: "The delivery of our bioenergy plant is part of our continued commitment to and substantial investment in the Suriname forestry industry. Today, our Suriname operations are in the development stage and where we are investing our capital. Tomorrow, through our aggressive sales and marketing efforts we expect to export high quality FSC certified sustainable forest products from Suriname to markets around the world including North America, China, Europe and the Caribbean nations.

Mr. Tony Wood, Regional Operations Manager of Greenheart Suriname said: "Our plan is to replicate our world-class Apoera wood processing operations including the new bioenergy plant into other geographic regions in Suriname further developing the forestry industry and creating jobs. We will do this in a fully transparent manner and in accordance with all existing Suriname laws and regulations. We would like to thank everyone involved in the

challenging transportation of our bioenergy plant components from Paramaribo to Apoera. These include N.V. Energie Bedrijven, the Suriname Port Authorities, Telesur, the Suriname police force for their support throughout the journey and the people who had to put up with the inconvenience of slow moving traffic."
